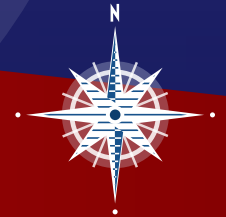


# ANNUAL REPORT OF GIVING 2020

David Troutman

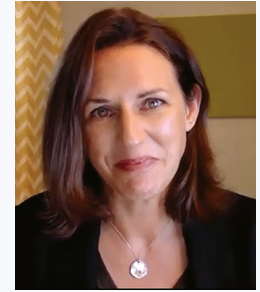
**The College and the Foundation honored two alumni with the “Alum of the Year Award” in 2020.**

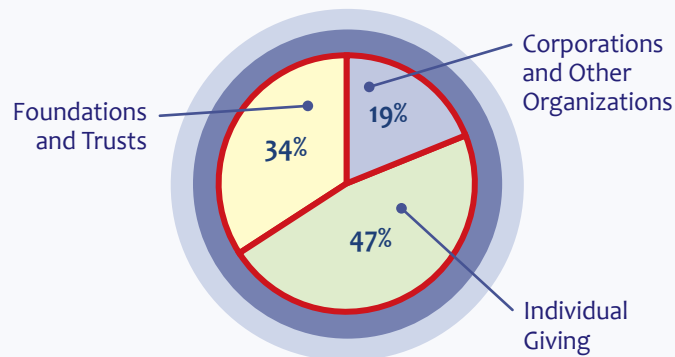
